Important dates for the 2010 season fundraising efforts:

Please start collecting and turning in cans and bottles now. We are asking for each player to collect \$25 of cans and bottles. Drop off locations are at Baldwinsville Bottle & Can Return at the River Mall on Downer Street or the Baldwinsville Redemption Center located at 53 Salina Street (Rt. 370). The team that has the highest level of participation for the cans and bottles will have a pizza party after one of their home games.

3/04 Cookie dough order forms are distributed to players. We are asking for each player to sell 17 boxes and each player who does so will receive the B'Ville Lacrosse shirt. Each player who sells 22 boxes will have their name entered into the drawing for \$50 Visa gift cards.
